Transportation

The Hawaii County Mass Transit Agency provides public transportation around the island on the Hele-On bus. All buses are wheelchair accessible. In addition, the Transit Agency offers a Shared-Ride Taxi program which provides door-to-door transportation for as little as \$2.00 within the urbanized area of Hilo and Kona with priority given to medical related trips. Coupons must be purchased in advance for this taxi service.
